The mission of the Indonesia Australia Business Council is to provide a convivial networking organisation for companies, organisations and business people of all nationalities involved or interested in business between Indonesia and Australia.

Events/Functions

To provide maximum networking opportunity and to communicate business and investment opportunities both in Indonesia and Australia to members, the IABC organizes the following regular events:

- **Breakfast Briefing** – technical and information session on relevant topics with speakers who are experts in their fields.
- **Business Luncheon/Dinner** – with prominent speakers such as ministers or experts on issues affecting business and investment.
- **IABC Members Gathering** – the most popular and well attended monthly business networking event in Jakarta.
- **Seminar and Business Conference** – major business event organized every two years jointly with our sister organization Australia-Indonesia Business Council (AIBC).
- **IABC New Year Party** – annual party/dinner to celebrate the New Year with great food and entertainment, and it is free for members.
- **Trade Missions & Business Trips** – trade missions to Australia in conjunction with Ministerial visits or separately, and business trips to other regions of Indonesia to explore new business opportunities.
- **IABC President's Golf Day** – informal golf game which also provides social and business networking for members.
- **Member's rate** – for all events/functions organized by IABC, members can enjoy a member's rate.

Publication

The IABC publishes a monthly newsletter which provides relevant and useful information related to doing business in Indonesia. The newsletter is distributed free of charge to all members. The IABC also publishes the Membership Directory which lists all members and information about their business. The Directory is distributed to members and to offices of chambers of commerce and industry in Indonesia, Australia and the South East Asia region.

Representation
